Tungsten Fabric Induction Vote Results

- The following resolution was put forth to the TAC for email vote on December 5th, 2018
 - Shall the TAC recommend to the Governing Board that Tungsten Fabric be inducted into the Linux Foundation Networking Fund? Please vote +1, 0, -1
- > 19 votes were cast out of the 32 members of the TAC
 - > 17 votes For
 - > 2 votes Against
- As per section 8.c of the LFN Charter, the Vote passes with a majority of 53%



Future Methods of Populating The TAC

Section 7b of the LFN Charter States:

"For the first twelve months following the initial meeting of the Governing Board and until otherwise determined by the TAC pursuant to Section 7.c., the voting members of 8 the TAC consist of: i) one representative appointed by each Platinum Member; and ii) one representative appointed by the technical oversight body (e.g., a Technical Steering Committee) of each TAC Project. c) At any time following the first anniversary of the initial meeting of the Governing Board, the TAC may by vote decide upon an alternate structure for voting representation on the TAC, subject to the approval of the Governing Board."
