Minutes

OVP ONS Announcements / Launch

- Lincoln/Rabi/Heather will give the LFN Board an update on OVP on Tuesday.
 Heather later also shared the slides that will be presented to the Board.
- Huawei is sponsoring a tutorial on OVP and how to get involved on Wednesday.
- Two CVC meetings (one with EUAG) are taking place during the unconference on Thursday. Currently only F2F sessions are being planned but Zoom bridge may be added if space and audio are conducive.
- Margaret and Heather are organizing a panel discussion on Friday. Heather has shared on the CVC mailing list the spreadsheet on OVP Test Matrix that she pulled together based on the documentation available in Read the Docs for the Casablanca release. She will uplevel this into high-level summaries and simplify the terminology to present on Friday's panel with Margaret.
- A press release to announce the availability of the OVP program will go live on Wednesday. The focus of this announcement is to raise the profile of the work the technical teams and the CVC are doing. A follow-up announcement will be planned once there is a cohort of vendors who are certified through the program.

OVP Reviewers and Portal Admin

- Rabi collected the list of Committee members who have volunteered to be reviewers and portal admins.
- Rabi pointed out the need to increase the number of portal admins and to diversity the VNF reviewer pool. He recommended having training sessions on how to use the portal and on understanding Dovetail/SDK result output.

CVC / EUAG Meeting Planning

- Lincoln shared the EUAG survey results. The overall takeaways are:
 - The differentiation between priorities is not significant.

- VNF is ranked as the greatest priority with NFVI/VIM, MANO, Interop following in the order of prioritization from the greatest to the least.
- Performance testing seems to be a lower priority than functional and validation testing.
- Sample size: the EUAG survey received 9 responses and the Board survey received 9 response. The results between the two surveys are similar with one noted difference that the interop topic was ranked slightly higher than MANO in the Board survey.
- The attendees provided the following feedback/suggestions to help Lincoln prepare slides for the CVC meeting with EUAG at ONS.
 - Need to introduce/clarify the purpose of the survey.
 - Need to get alignment on what can be realistically accomplished in the next release cycle and the vision/direction where the program is headed.
 - Validation testing is identified as the next highest priority, need to define the requirements for the VNF test environment.
 - Improve resources allocated to the testing projects. Try to tell one testing story (one strategy, one list of priority, common approaches and etc.)
 - Committee members are encouraged to add additional comments to <u>Lincoln's survey takeaway doc</u>. Lincoln will consolidate/process the feedback into slides and share them with the Committee on Tuesday as CVC's interpretations of the EUAG survey results.
