- > Not to have a Developer Forum co-located with ONS
- > Bring back project-based technical sessions and interweave these into ONS tracks
- > ONS-Amsterdam this year (Sept. 25-27) will be 3-days in total
- > ONS-N. America (in San Jose, CA) next year will be 4-days in total
- > To keep things fair and equal across all projects (LFN, other LF hosted projects, ONF etc.) we will NOT accept any co-located minisummits/dev days etc. for ONS in the future.
 - > All content must be accepted within the main conference CFP.
