- OPNFV projects have Many Stakeholders in CNTT...
- But, attracting developers and inter-project communications are a key issue:
 - Functest and Xtesting does not have a critical mass of developers (Baldy tracking list items)
 - Without showing corporate sponsors sufficient value, developers will not be reassigned
 - SPC feedback: the separation, communication, and roles CNTT and OPNFV seems to be a key part of the problem
 - Complete Requirements and success criteria are not available from CNTT developers taking a hands-on iterative approach to show what is possible (Open Source approach)
- CNTT should be a Key focus for OPNFV: deliverable list for CNTT Baldy for ONES-NA as a starting point for developing list of tasks OPNFV to work on https://wiki.lfnetworking.org/display/LN/CNTT+TSC+Master+Tracker+Baldy
 - How to translate into OPNFV activities (through TSC, CIRV project, other), what is OPNFV response?
- Discussed example of developers driving performance testing
 - Seen by some as low priority or not important but others believe value of CNTT cannot be realized without performance testing
 - Testers spent > 2months struggling to get a stable install of RI using Airship due to lack of developer resources
- SPC: "Cloud-native is very different than anything most people are familiar with ... to figure this out you need to get code under your fingernails"
- OPNFV TSC to Continue this discussion, Communicate with CNTT, RETURN in 2 weeks to meet with SPC
- SPC: "this was best meeting in a long time"
