

### Q1 What best describes Your primary Job Role?





### Q2 What best describes the type of company you work for?





### Q3 What geographic region do you do most of your work from?





## Q4 What open source Project Role(s) in the context of Linux Foundation Networking (LFN) do you perform? (Select all that apply)









### Q7 What is your level of satisfaction with the use of standard LFN collaboration tools (e.g. JIRA, Confluence, groups.io)?





## Q8 What is your level of satisfaction with the use of chat tools in your project (e.g. IRC, slack)?





## Q9 Would your project be interested in using a new, open source, LF hosted chat tool for your project(s)?



# Q10 In a typical week, what percentage of your time do you spend working in the open source community (up-stream) versus working internally on company specific initiatives?




### Q11 Satisfaction: What is your feeling with respect to your overall experience with the LFN projects with which you engage?








## Q15 What actions would be most beneficial to improve collaboration between LFN projects and those outside the LFN umbrella?

# Q16 Open Source Governance: Do you feel that the LFN staff provided expert and timely guidance regarding the governance and processes used in your project?




#### Q17 Open Source Governance: Do you feel that LFN takes a fair and unbiased approach to assisting the community with their governance and process issues?



### Q18 How effective was the Technical Program Manager (TPM) assigned to your project with respect to sharing information and resolving issues?





### Q19 Infrastructure overall: Does the CI/CD system (build and test) meet your needs?





### Q20 Infra: Availability: Is the CI/CD system available and operating properly when you need it?







### Q22 Infra support: Are tickets/issues submitted to helpdesk/JIRA resolved in a timely manner?







### Q24 Developer Gatherings (LFN Developer & Testing Forums): Have you been satisfied with the quarterly developer gatherings that you attended?







### Q26 What is your biggest challenge to increased LFN engagement?




