Documentation purposes

- Main documentation for a project
 - To understand the global framework
 - To navigate in the various activities
 - To help using the components
- Sub-projet/module documentation
 - Mainly for the developers
 - Documentation associated with the code

HowTo attract new contributors ?

- Statement: contribution journey too complex
 - A few users contribute to the documentation
 - Information disseminated
 - LFN (Gerrit)
 - Wiki
 - Project
- Any good idea welcome

Wiki vs RST/MD

- Wiki
 - Good for project management: minutes, agenda, presentation
 - Not adapted for review, scripts
 - Not aligned with release management
 - Translation possible towards RST (eg Pandoc for Mediawiki)
- RST/MD
 - Managed as code, review
 - More difficult for non-developers

Some challenges

- Avoid wiki for official documentation
- More automation required
 - Linting, spell checker, link checker
- More reviews required from native speakers
- Improve user feedbacks an their journey to contribute
- No Doc = No release ?
