Why ODL in docker?

- There has been an increased interest in Network controller services available as micro services for configuration in cloud environments.
- In the past, docker images were manually added to dockerhub.
- We are trying to create images of ODL with current releases for testing.

Current Status

- There are no dockerfile/helm documentation in community for user tryout.
- We are working to create a image repository for Opendaylight docker images.

Requirements of an image

- A simple pom.xml and Dockerfile should be created
All these options will be supported (to be discussed)
 - Image creation using any of the distribution(auto release build, official release).
 - Image creation based on ODL with just a single feature.
 - Image creation with odlmicro or other packaging

Tasks

- Creation of dockerfile and pom.xml - in progress
- Add options to use any image (odlmicro, static distro with any feature)
