- Single point of abstraction across multiple hardware vendors
- Right now 18 contributors across 3 companies
- · Currently a single project, may grow to multiple projects. Appropriate multi-project governance will be put in place if/when that happens.

- ODIM set up to span multiple verticals focus is physical devices.
   Hyperscalers never expose physical devices. ODIM is for bare metal. Hyperscalers could use ODIM for that.
