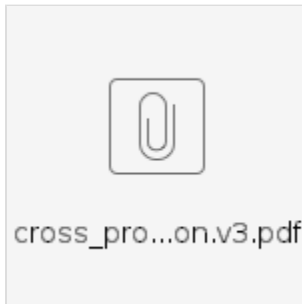

- [Ranny Haiby](#) asked if there was an end-user cheat sheet or versioning for the badging program.
 - [Lincoln Lavoie](#) There is a guideline process documentation. However, we are still improving our documentation.
 - [Marc Price](#) provided additional context to the drivers for each of the badging options and agreed that the information should be clarified for new users.
